New Testament Survey – Ephesians thru Revelation Survey-6

Purpose: This survey course will provide an overview of the last eighteen books of the New Testament as they relate to the spread of the Gospel and the work of the Holy Spirit in relationship to the person and works of Jesus Christ. We shall answer the who, whom, what, why, where, and when questions regarding each book with emphasis on the writer, the recipients, and the political and social setting

General Overview: About the same time as the four Gospels were gathered together to form one collection, another collection of Christian documents was also being made – the collection of Paul’s letters. These two collections – The Gospels and The Apostles, as they were called – make up the greater part of our New Testament. We have studied nine of these books – Matthews thru Galatians - in Survey fashion and are now ready to complete that process. We will first exam three of the four “*Prison Epistle*” (Ephesians, Philippians, and Colossians), pause briefly and then begin our examination of First and Second Thessalonians. Next we will survey the “*Pastoral Epistles*” (First and Second Timothy and Titus) and end Paul’s letters with Philemon the fourth of the Prison Epistles. The course will end with the survey of the remaining nine “*General Epistles*” (Hebrews, James, First and Second Peter, One, two, and Three John, Jude and finally the book of Revelation)

Within these New Testament epistles, we witness the political world being prepared for the Christian era as well as the social-economic world in like fashion being readied for Christianity. Finally, we are privy to the religious world being primed for the body of Christ, which is the church – pagan polytheism confronted with Christian monotheism.
